

APPENDIX L JR PEE WEES

With the exception of the below listed conditions, all rules governing NORCALFED football will be adhered to.

1. Two (2) coaches per team will be on the field, but they must remain fifteen (15) yards behind the line of scrimmage.
2. Each player on the roster must play a minimum of twelve (12) plays.
3. There will be no kick-offs, the ball will be put into play from the offensive forty (40) yard line.
4. Touchdowns are worth one (1) point, (to keep scores down). No P.A.T. allowed. No overtime. Tie scores; remain a tie. No standings posted, nor post season playoffs. No posting of scores on internet or local media allowed.
5. A team may kick a punt or "declare" a punt. If they choose to kick a punt, no movement other than long snap is allowed by either team until the ball is kicked. Regular punt rules then apply. However no fake punts are allowed. A team can declare a "punt". The ball is then moved twenty (20) yards and the other team takes over possession. No "punting" of any kind allowed inside the opponents thirty-five (35) yard line.
6. On a safety, the ball will be placed on the twenty (20) yard line of team A (offense). The ball is then "free kicked" to the forty (40) yard line and the other team (team B) takes over possession.
7. Blitzing is prohibited. More than six (6) man defensive front line is prohibited, and will result in a **unsportsmanlike conduct penalty**.
8. Scores will be shown on scoreboard.
9. At anytime the score is more than a four (4) touchdown spread, the twenty-eight (28) point rules will apply (*see pg 13.7*) with the exception of the kickoff and the running clock **not** being required in the fourth (4th) quarter unless requested by the team that is behind.
10. Fumbles and interceptions remain live per the high school rulebook.

EXCEPTION: Any fumbles or interceptions behind the line of scrimmage result in a dead ball and loss of down in the first four (4) games of the season.
